



Volunteer Position Descriptions



Scoring

Volunteers will be in the scoring tent as well as working with the Duramed Futures Team on Scoring. Other duties include Score-Board posting and delivery of Checked Score-Cards to Tour Operations Trailer.

Real Time Scoring

Real time scorers will be responsible for collecting unofficial scores for posting to the Duramed FUTURES Tour website. Volunteers will be needed to be hole reporters collecting scores from the cart drivers, to monitor the radio transmissions from the hole reporters and main leaderboard, and to input scores for upload to the website.

Marshal/ Spotter

Marshals are responsible for gallery control and safety. They also assist the professionals by spotting balls and preventing outside agencies from interfering with play.

Standard Bearer

Volunteers will walk 18 holes carrying a sign containing current names and scores. (Great Position for juniors and Young Adults)

Cart Driver

Volunteer cart drivers drive the cart that carries the bags for each group of Duramed FUTURES Tour Professionals. They also keep unofficial score for each of the players in their group, which they turn in after nine holes.

Shuttle Cart Driver

Volunteer shuttle drivers drive the players and guests to the driving range, parking area, and course entrance.

Driving Range

Volunteers are needed to help distribute Range balls. Keep the range clean and organized for the players.

Timing

Timing volunteers are responsible for assisting in maintaining the pace of play during the days of the tournament. Each volunteer will work closely with the Duramed Futures Tour Rules Officials. Volunteers will be strategically placed throughout the course. Volunteers need to be golf knowledgeable.

Housing

Volunteers are those who are interested in housing a Pro during the week of the tournament. (RCC Members Only)

Main Gate/Parking

Volunteers are needed to work at the main gate and direct traffic to the appropriate areas.

Pro-AM (no uniform required)

Volunteers are needed with the smooth running of the Pro Am events on Wednesday and Thursday of tournament week. Positions include registration, spotters for hole in one and other support activities.
